### **HOMBAT survey on combating homophobic and transphobic bullying in schools!**

The large study tackling the issue of Homophobic and Transphobic (HT) bullying in schools has just started in 3 European countries (Greece, Cyprus, Lithuania), in the context of the new EU project "[HOMBAT - Combating HOMophoBic And Transphobic bullying in schools](#)" for the prevention and combating of HT bullying in schools.

The survey is aimed at **the entire educational community in primary and secondary schools** (teachers, school advisors, school psychologists etc). The objective is to identify the occurrence and, mainly, the characteristics of discrimination and bullying on the grounds of sexual orientation, gender identity and gender characteristics in primary and secondary school environments.
